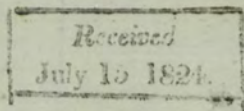

I have received information that the Government of Columbia have sent Agents to the Province of Guatemala to induce them to join that Republic, as the Government of Spain always pretended to include the Mosquito Shore in the said Government, I have thought it proper to prevent future disputes to issue a Proclamation, declaring any such pretended claims on my Kingdom to be groundless, and that I have no alliance or connexion with any Government but that of Great Britain.

I have also decided on hoisting a National Flag, a drawing of which is inclosed and I trust it will meet with

every attention and assistance
from you.

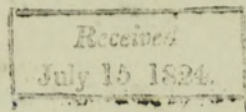
